Submit an abstract and chances are you may be offered the opportunity to do one or more of the following:

Make an Oral Presentation to close a symposium

If your submission aligns with one of the symposium topics you may be invited to close that session with a presentation of your work. This will be in addition to the poster presentation.

Participation in a Poster Round Presentation

After a highly successful venture in Dubrovnik2012, poster rounds over lunchtime led by a facilitator comparing outcomes presented across a range of posters under a specific theme will be included. These sessions attract a large numbers of participants (specialists in their fields, poster presenters, and individual delegates).

Present a Clinical Case

This will be a lively, interactive session including electronic voting on results interpretation, differential diagnosis and clinical outcome. Led by an 'old hand', Dr Danielle Freedman supports lively participation at this conference closing symposium.

Please note:

Submit your abstract through the web site: www.eurolabfocus2014.org. The abstract title should not exceed 20 words and the text can be up to a maximum of 300 words. Figures and tables should not be included in the abstract. Abstracts must:

- state the specific aim of the study
- state methods used, if pertinent
- summarise results obtained
- state conclusions reached
- statements such as 'data will be presented' or 'results will be discussed' will lead to rejection
